

**Texas – Postdoctoral Associate: Bioenergy.** A postdoctoral position is available immediately in the Department of Soil & Crop Sciences at Texas A&M University to investigate soil factors linked to the sustainable production of biofuel oilseed crops. This includes the interactive impacts of agronomic systems, biomass removal, and land application of biofuel residues on soil organic carbon sequestration, levels and dynamics, and soil microbial diversity and activity. The successful applicant will have the opportunity to interact with a diverse group of researchers involved in a variety of bioenergy-related projects. Required qualifications include: 1) Ph.D. in agronomy, soil science, microbiology, or a related field; 2) experience with molecular methods for characterization of microbial communities; 3) experience with methods for soil carbon analysis; and 4) effective communication skills.
